Homelessness **AUSTRALIA** in Australia

The Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) recently released the official homelessness estimates, showing that on Census night 2016, 116,427 Australians were experiencing homelessness. This is an increase of nearly 14% from 2011 and comes as no surprise to Mission Australia, as staff in our services and others across the sector have witnessed rising levels of need since the last census.
